DISCIPLESHIP TRAINING SCHOOL

Thank you for your interest in our Discipleship Training School (DTS), which is a part of Youth With A Mission (YWAM) and the gateway into the seven Colleges/Faculties offered by the University of the Nations (DSP 211/212). This school is registered with the University of the Nations. (U of N) and you will receive up to 20 UofN credits upon completion of this course.

The course runs for **5 months** and is divided into two phases: a three-month lecture phase followed by a two-month outreach. It is a **bilingual** course (Portuguese and English) as we receive students from all over Brazil, and other nations, which offer the student a variety of cross culture experiences. YWAM Recife offers four DTS per year, one in January, April (with a focus on Community Development), July, and October (with a focus on Children at Risk).

The purpose of the five-month DTS is to help you develop a dynamic love relationship with Jesus, and cause you to want to obey Christ's last command, "Go and make disciples of all nations..." (Matt.28:19). We desire to send forth laborers to the mission fields of the world-from the jungles of the Amazon, to the concrete jungles of New York City.

The DTS program emphasizes heart transformation and character development, not the accumulation of knowledge. It's a journey to discover the heart of God and learn His ways. In DTS, knowing God personally and intimately is the bottom line! The DTS is a schools designed to lay a foundation in your life which will equip you to make a dynamic difference in your world.

REQUIREMENTS FOR DTS

- Applicants must be at least 18 years old (or have a high-school diploma)
- Authorization from parents if you are a minor

INFORMATION ABOUT LECTURE PHASE

CURRICULUM - Some of the subjects that will be covered are:

1. Hearing God's voice
2. The character and ways of God
3. Relationship with God and others
4. Forgiveness and the Fear of the Lord
5. Worship and spiritual warfare
6. Basic homiletics
7. The Father heart of God
8. Evangelism and world missions

* The curriculum is not in order and is subject to change.

*The official language of Brazil is Portuguese. Although we do translate the classroom teaching and official activities of the school, everything else is in Portuguese and we are not always able to provide translation at all times. So we encourage you to come expecting to learn some Portuguese

EXTRA CURRICULAR

NIKO is a three-day outdoor training experience, which uses dynamic activities that tests and trains the student in three principle areas: serving, teamwork and leadership development. During the school, you will be participating in an evangelistic event with the base staff. There will be an extra tool before the outreach.

REQUIRED READING

There are three books to read that will complement the classroom curriculum.

DAILY SCHEDULE

An average day during the lecture phase might look like below. Evenings are usually free to study and relax, but there will be some school meetings after dinner.

* **WORK DUTIES** - Each student works about two hours a day on the base in areas such as kitchen clean up, ground maintenance and housekeeping. The goal of these work duties is to encourage a servant's heart. The Bible encourages us to do everything as unto the Lord. Working hard and with joy is a class in itself and therefore a vital part of the training.

- 2) This cost above is to cover food, housing, electricity, travel of teachers during the classroom phase. You will receive housing (dormitory style) and 3 meals a day. You will need to bring extra money for snacks, days off, personal spending etc.
- 3) **NIKO and the Impact are held off campus.** The amount above will cover the costs: travel, housing and food.
- 4) In case it is not clear how the monthly discount works, here is an example. If the opening day of DTS starts on the 21th, the discount is valid if you pay by the 23th and by the 23th of each following month.

INFORMATION OF OUTREACH COST

The outreach costs are not included in the costs listed below and will be announced, along with the location of the outreach, during the lecture phase of the school. The outreach is an essential part of DTS in order to conclude the school and the student will be given possible locations to pray over and choose from. Whether you participate in an outreach at another YWAM base, ministry, church, etc. within or outside of Brazil, you will be responsible to raise your own housing, airfare, visa, travel and health insurance fees. **The student will only be released for the outreach phase once the fees for the lecture phase are paid.**
